We would love to share with you this letter that was sent to Paul Sadler.

I am writing this letter to you following a life changing incident that occurred during our family holiday to Fraser Island in Queensland during January this year.

As you may be aware, Fraser Island is off the Queensland coast some three hours north of Brisbane. This is the second time we have been there as it is a picturesque location and a great place to unwind. This year, my wife, two sons and I travelled there with another family of six which included three 7-year olds and an 11-year old.

After spending eight days on the island enjoying the lakes, surf and fishing our holiday turned upside down. Just like any family, we stopped along the beach for a spot of fishing and swimming. Within a matter of seconds all of the children had entered the water and were being swept out to sea.

My younger child, a Maxi-Pink, had the ability to catch the next wave and body surf into shore. My older child, who has his Caramel Certificate, was called in to help the younger children who were being carried out further as they are not strong swimmers. The shock of the situation made them panic and quickly pandemonium set in.

Two of the children were within 75 metres of the shore and were retrieved by their father; however, the other two seven-year olds and my eldest son continued being swept out. By the time I reached the children, panic had set in and the only person coping with the situation was my son. He had nothing else on his mind but to save the two kids. He tread water, while holding them either side, for a long period of time until I was able to reach them. Once he was free, his words of encouragement to both my wife and myself while retrieving the children cannot be praised more highly. He then swam back to shore (some 100 metres) against the rip and radioed for help. We are extremely proud of him.

We all managed to make it back to shore safely and once the initial shock had subsided it made us all appreciate the life-saving skills that swimming lessons provide.

The children have enjoyed your swimming clinic for about three years and have had previous lessons. I would personally like to thank all the staff from Swimland who have taught both boys over the last few years, for not only giving them the skills in saving themselves, but for saving the lives of others.
